Thank you for participating in the 23rd Annual White Plains St. Patrick's Day Parade, scheduled for:

Saturday, March 14th, at Noon. This Parade is rain, snow or shine!

The following Parade guidelines will assist you with the event:

1.) Group Leader – Check in by 11:15am at the check-in tables on Mamaroneck Avenue. **NOTE:** Escort and Division 1 & 2 check in at corner of Mamaroneck Ave/Old Mamaroneck Rd. Divisions 3-4 on Mamaroneck Ave near Citgo. Look for white tents. (Your group members may arrive up to 11:30am.) Look for Committee Members in Sashes.

2.) Parade Marchers – Drop off at Mamaroneck Avenue at Rutherford Avenue (TD Bank) (for Divisions 1 or 2) and at Bloomingdale Road (Divisions 3-4).

Parking for Cars – Available in the Chester/Maple and in the Hamilton Avenue/Main Street Parking Garages. Also, the new Lyons Place garage is in the heart of town.

All Buses/Bands – Enter off Bryant Avenue to Old Mamaroneck Road to drop off Band Members on corner of Old Mamaroneck Road no later than 11:15am. Then proceed down Mamaroneck Avenue to Main Street and left onto Conroy Drive to park until the parade ends.

- **All Parade Floats will line up on Mamaroneck Avenue and Old Mamaroneck Road. If you are on a float – go there.**

3.) The Parade Route begins at the corner of Old Mamaroneck Road and Livingston Avenue, proceeding down Mamaroneck Avenue to Main Street, ending just past City Hall – the reviewing stand will be on the steps of City Hall, so feel free to salute dignitaries, but **DO NOT STOP**. Estimated Parade length is 60 minutes.

- Make sure to leave 25' space between each group when marching.
- Adults, when walking with youth groups, let youths march in front of adults for safety.
- **Please do not throw giveaway items from vehicles.**
- **IMPORTANT: The use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) otherwise known as “Drones” is strictly forbidden during the White Plains St. Patrick's Day Parade. This includes all marching units, bands, and spectators.**

4.) Parade held rain or shine – **ONLY** in the event of a major storm, parade may be canceled. If so, call (914) 686-0239 as of 9:00am for a recorded message or check our website.

5.) Please come dressed, as there are NO changing facilities available. Port-a-potties are at the lineup area.
